The school intends to provide an intensive training course for Ph.D. students and young researchers who are working in the fields of international economic and development. This year it will focus on the political economy of international trade, with a particular emphasis on trade in services.

## Participants

The school is targeted to doctoral students and post-doctoral researchers in economics and related disciplines. Students are expected to attend the school full time. Accommodation and meals will be provided during the Summer School free of charge.

Early Stage Researchers and Experienced Researchers employed in the GIST network at the time of the summer school will cover their travel expenses using their Participation Allowance budget. Former GIST Early Stage Researchers and Experienced Researchers are strongly encouraged to apply. There will be some funding available to cover their travel expenses. Some travel funding will be available also to students not part of the GIST network. Priority will be given to students from Developing Countries.
