There is no registration fee for selected participants but travel expenses are not covered. The Conference is organised by Centro Studi Luca d'Agliano, jointly with the University of Milan and the Department of Economics at the University of Milan Bicocca. It is an annual event and it honours the memory of Riccardo Faini, who always strived to provide graduate students with opportunities to broaden their views by interacting with each other and engaging with more established international researchers.

Decisions of acceptance will be announced no later than July 15, 2008. Final versions of the papers will be due on August 20, 2008.
