9.30 – 10.30 *Keynote Speech* by David Throsby, Macquarie University, Australia

David Throsby is internationally known for his work in the economics of the arts and culture. His book *The Economics of the Performing Arts*, co-authored with Glenn Withers, first published in 1979 and reissued in 1993, has become a standard reference work in the field. In addition to the performing arts, Professor Throsby's research and writing has covered the economic role of artists, the economics of public intervention in arts markets, cultural development, cultural policy, heritage issues, and sustainability of cultural processes. He has also written extensively on the theory of public goods and the economics of higher education. He was a member of the Experts Committee for drafting the UN Convention on Cultural Diversity (2003-04) UNESCO.
